STATE OF MICHIGAN MARINE SAFETY ACT OF 1967 (Act 303 – P.A. 1967)

SEC. 73. A person who is under the influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotic drugs, barbitol or any derivation of barbitol, or any person who is an habitual user of narcotic drugs, barbitol or any derivative or barbitol, shall not operate, propel or be in actual physical control of any vessel upon any waters of this state. The owner of any vessel or any person having it in charge or in control thereof shall not knowingly authorize or knowingly permit the vessel to be propelled or operated by any person who is under the influence of any intoxicating liquor or narcotic drugs, barbitol or any derivative of barbitol, or any person who is an habitual user of narcotic drugs, barbitol or any derivative of barbitol.

SEC. 74. A person who operates any vessel, upon any of the waters of this state, carelessly and heedlessly in disregard of the rights or safety of others, or without due caution and circumspection and at a speed or in a manner so as to endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property, is guilty of reckless operation of a vessel and shall be punished as provided in Section 166.

SEC. 111. All vessels when in operation SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH LIFE-SAVING DEVICES as follows: 1 Coast Guard approved LIFE PRESERVER, VEST, RING BUOY or BUOYANT CUSHION FOR EACH PERSON on board.
